## VOLUNTEER INFORMATION SHEET

- Sanctuary Volunteers
  - All potential volunteers must attend a Volunteer Orientation Tour prior to volunteering time.
    - Orientation tours are held every Saturday at 8:30am and are subject to availability.
    - Group orientation tours are scheduled on a case by case basis. If you plan on having more than 4 people in your group please email about scheduling your tour.
  - There is no minimum age for a sanctuary volunteer. Any minors must be accompanied by a responsible adult while on the property.
  - All volunteers must complete and sign a volunteer waiver form prior to volunteering time. Email the above-mentioned contact for a waiver.
    - Waivers are sent digitally. They are also fillable on your computer. You can simply download the attachment and fill out on your computer and email back to us. Save the file under the name the waiver is for.
    - All persons interested in volunteering must have a waiver signed. This includes minors. For minors, a parent or legal guardian must fill out the waiver and sign for them.
  - Once you have completed your orientation tour, you are able to come volunteer your time whenever you would like.
    - Volunteers who have completed the above steps must use a link available on our website to schedule the time they wish to volunteer every time they want to come out. The link can be found at <https://www.betterpiggiesrescue.org/volunteer>. Click the “Schedule Volunteer Service Time” button and follow the instructions.
    - You can only schedule service time once an orientation tour has been completed.
  - Donations are always accepted. Acceptable donations are the following:
    - Fresh produce (No onions, radish, or hot peppers (bell peppers – ok))
    - Blankets which do not contain stuffing
    - Pot belly pig pellets
    - Cheerios
    - For all others please contact first
  - All visits to the sanctuary must be scheduled. You can schedule by contacting us by email or by the website link.
- Rules of the Sanctuary
  - There is no running while on the property
  - Close all gates behind you. This includes the main gate.
  - If any pig escapes their enclosure, you are to immediately notify Rescue personnel.
  - All persons on the property must have a waiver signed. Volunteers can bring guests with them when they come to volunteer but they must have a waiver form completed before entering the sanctuary.
  - We ask no one enter the house on the property without direct consent from Rescue personnel.
  - All visits are scheduled.

- Action Volunteer Team (AVT)
  - Our Action Volunteer Team is for volunteers who are willing to assist us on the go.
  - AVT members assist us in a multitude of tasks such as:
    - Rescue operations
    - Animal pick up and transport
    - Home assessments
    - Event Assistance (Booths, Piggy Yoga, Etc.)
    - Emergency Call-outs
  - To join this team, you must attend an orientation tour and specifically request to be on the team.
  - AVT members are contacted by email, text, or by phone and notified of events that are upcoming, or of the task(s) we need assistance on.
  - There are no minimum requirements for an AVT member but the ideal AVT member will have reliable transportation and a willingness to help.
  - AVT members must remember they are representing Better Piggies Rescue and won't jeopardize the integrity or reputation of the organization.
